Past Events:

- Spooktacular
 - Suggestion of moving the event to the back parking lot because it is more lit and we could have our tables and food under the lit pavilion
 - Suggestion of putting a time limit on the trunks so those families could come and enjoy the other aspects of the night
 - We had a great turn out even had kids come that weren't at our school
 - People really liked that everything was free
 - Suggestion of marketing the event differently on the flier and have the trunk part start earlier and only run an hour
 - When the first trunk-or-treat happened they had chili and hot dogs so the suggestion was to start the trucks at 5:30 with food available
 - We already had people say they were in for next year
 - Lighting and lack of sound were issues for the story teller by the fire
 - Discussed having trunks from 5:30-6:30 and have everything else start at 6:30
- Halloween Parties
 - Had 2 games per class but no one to help at a lot of games therefore those parents did not get to spend time with their kids
 - There tends to be more parents involved if you have room parties
 - It was too overwhelming for the younger kids – had discussion about next year having the 8th grade stay with their little buddies even through snack time
 - Discussed possibly have Pre-K and Junior Kindergarten before everyone else next year and do a better job of explaining the ticket because they did not understand the system
 - For the free dress pass, there was a suggestion to have a gradual system, where the younger kids don't have to earn as many tickets because it is harder for them
 - 8th grade was unhappy because they lost the gym and felt like they were just babysitters
 - There was suggestion to separate the day to where 8th grade gets their own time
 - There were suggestions about having a longer time limit if we keep the parties in the gym

- There was discussion about separating the ticket cash out or have the free dress pass on its own table so there is not so much confusion at the end
- Pizza Sales
 - Raised \$13,728, that is \$4000 more than last year
 - Sold 1551 pizzas with Junior Kindergarten and 4th grade being top sellers
 - School wide top seller was Adam Kopp in 4th grade
 - Mrs. Etter and Fr. Joe will get to kiss a pig – discussed possibly doing so at the December 2 pep rally
 - Pre-K thru 4th get to pie their teachers in the face – 5th thru 8th did not meet the \$1000 goal
 - Kids were excited for incentives (mainly younger kids)
 - People with more kids were not as excited
 - It was brought up that our sales were right after the high school sold and Dennis promised that would not happen again but he didn't want to turn down people looking to raise money
 - There was discussion about possibly extending the time to sell – seemed shorter
 - Pick-Up is Nov. 20th from 8-12

 - Missy came to the meeting to discuss the scrips program and how it works
 - With the Schnucks card, all the money goes to the student
